AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to scheduling school lunch periods $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) +\left(1\right) +$

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 813 of the education law, as added by chapter 296 2 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

§ 813. School lunch period; scheduling. Each school shall schedule [a reasonable time] times for students to consume lunch that begin no earlier than two and one-half hours and no later than four hours after the start of the school day for each full day pupil attending pre-kindergarten through grade twelve [to consume lunch].

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of August occurring in 9 the year two years after which this act becomes a law.
