AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to providing the proposed
site location of a charter school at the time of application

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (j) of subdivision 2 of section 2851 of the
2 education law, as added by chapter 4 of the laws of 1998, is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 (j) Information regarding the facilities to be used by the school,
5 including the location of the school, if known, and the means by which
6 pupils will be transported to and from the school. If the facilities to
7 be used by the proposed school are not known at the time the application
8 is submitted, the applicant shall notify the charter entity and, if
9 applicable, the board of regents within ten business days of acquiring
10 facilities for such school; provided, however, that the charter school
11 must obtain a certificate of occupancy for such facilities prior to the
12 date on which instruction is to commence at the school. Notwithstanding
13 the foregoing, if the school is to be located in a building in which an
14 existing public school is located, the school's proposed location must
15 be identified at the time application is submitted.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
17 have become a law.
