AN ACT in relation to requiring the chairman of the New York city transportation authority to promulgate rules and regulations providing for certain means of transportation to be utilized at the request of paratransit-eligible persons

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The chairman of the New York city transportation authority shall promulgate rules and regulations providing for the use of specific vehicles upon the request of a paratransit-eligible person utilizing paratransit services of the authority, provided, however, such person shall submit to the chairman, written medical proof provided by a physician licensed pursuant to article 131 of the education law, on a form provided by the authority, that such vehicle is medically necessary to transport such person.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
