AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to prohibiting mort-gagee from refusing to accept partial mortgage payments

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 254-e to read as follows:
- § 254-e. Refusal by mortgagee to accept partial mortgage payments. 1.

 No mortgagee shall refuse to accept a partial payment of an entire

 amount due from a mortgagor which does not bring the mortgagor current

 on his or her mortgage debt.
- 7 <u>2. The provisions of this section shall not bar any other contractual</u> 8 <u>or statutory rights or remedies available to a mortgagor.</u>
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law.
