AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting vivisection at colleges and universities in the state where a scientifically and educationally satisfactory method or strategy exists

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to 2 read as follows:

<u>§ 817. Vivisection prohibited. 1. For purposes of this section:</u>

4 (a) "Vivisection" means experimentation through surgery on a living
 5 organism to view living internal structure.

(b) "Scientifically and educationally satisfactory method or strategy"
means a teaching method or strategy that accomplishes the goal of the
proposed education or training or teaching method or strategy that is
used by a majority of other institutions of higher education to accomplish the same goal.
2. Vivisection is prohibited at all colleges, universities, profes-

12 sional, proprietary or graduate schools in the state where an alterna-

13 <u>tive scientifically and educationally satisfactory method or strategy</u> 14 <u>exists.</u>

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 16 it shall have become a law.
