Introduced by M. of A. CYMBROWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Housing

AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to requiring that the New York city housing authority include a notice informing a prospective tenant or tenant of the ability to add legal occupants to the lease or renewal lease, and provide, upon request, a tenant with a form to add additional legal occupants

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivisions 7, 8 and 9 of section 402 of the public housing law, subdivision 8 as renumbered by chapter 467 of the laws of 1971, are renumbered subdivisions 8, 9 and 10 and a new subdivision 7 is added to read as follows:
- 7. a. The New York city housing authority shall include, along with
 every lease or renewal lease offered to a prospective tenant or current
 tenant, a separate, clear and conspicuous notice, in at least sixteenpoint boldface type, concerning the tenant's ability to add additional
 legal occupants to the lease agreement.
- b. Upon receipt of a tenant's request for a form to add an additional legal occupant, the authority shall, within seven days, provide the tenant with the appropriate form, along with a notice informing the tenant of the right to contest the denial of any occupancy permission request.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
