AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to limiting the contingency budget of a school district

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 4 of section 2023 of the education law, as amended by section 3 of part A of chapter 97 of the laws of 2 2011, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. The contingency budget shall not result in the lesser of (i) a tax
4 levy greater than the tax levied for the prior school year; or (ii) the
5 dollar amount of the lowest, proposed, defeated budget for the applica-
6 ble school year. For the purposes of this paragraph, the same types of
7 expenditures excluded from the calculation of total spending for the
8 proposed budget shall be excluded when calculating the total spending in
9 the contingency budget.

10 § 2. Paragraph a of subdivision 4 of section 2023 of the education law, as amended by section 24 of part A of chapter 436 of the laws of 11 1997, is amended to read as follows:

12 a. The contingency budget shall not result in a percentage increase in
13 total spending over the district's total spending under the school
14 district budget for the prior school year that exceeds the lesser of:
15 (i) the result obtained when one hundred twenty percent is multiplied by
16 the percentage increase in the consumer price index, with the result
17 rounded to two decimal places; ~~or~~ (ii) four percent; or (iii) the
18 dollar amount of the lowest, proposed, defeated budget for the applica-
19 ble school year. For the purposes of this paragraph, the same types of
20 expenditures excluded from the calculation of total spending for the
21 proposed budget shall be excluded when calculating the total spending in
22 the contingency budget.

23 EXPLANATION--Matter in italics (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
24 [-] is old law to be omitted.

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1 § 3. This act shall take effect on the first of May next succeeding
2 the date on which it shall have become a law; provided that the amend-
3 ments to section 2023 of the education law, made by section one of this
4 act, shall not affect the expiration of such section and shall expire
5 therewith, when upon such date the provisions of section two of this act
6 shall take effect.
