AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the dispensing of drugs by pharmacists to veterinarians

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 6807 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows: <u>4. A pharmacist may dispense drugs, including veterinary-specific</u> <u>compounded medications, to a veterinarian, and a veterinarian may</u> <u>possess and keep in stock for administration and sale, such drugs pursu-</u> <u>ant to a non-patient specific regimen prescribed or ordered by any prac-</u> <u>titioner of veterinary medicine licensed pursuant to article one hundred</u> <u>thirty-five of this title.</u> § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
