AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to covered employment as a domestic worker for temporary disability benefits

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 202 of the workers' compensation law, as amended by chapter 65 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows:

- 2. The provisions of subdivision one of this section shall not apply to an employer of personal or domestic employees in a private home, except an employer shall become a covered employer from and after the expiration of four weeks following the employment of one or more personal or domestic employees who work for a minimum of [forty] twenty hours per week for such employer and are employed on each of at least thirty days in any calendar year.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
