AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing licensees to sell liquor and/or wine for off-premises consumption on Sundays

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 14 of section 105 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by section 1 of part U of chapter 3 63 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) No premises licensed to sell liquor and/or wine for off-premises consumption shall be permitted to remain open:
- (i) On Sunday before [twelve o'clock post meridian] ten o'clock antemeridian and after nine o'clock post meridian.
 - (ii) On any day between midnight and eight o'clock antemeridian.
 - (iii) On the twenty-fifth day of December, known as Christmas day.
- 10 In any community where daylight saving time is in effect, such time 11 shall be deemed the standard time for the purpose of this subdivision.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
- 13 have become a law.
