AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assault in the second degree upon a supervisory member of a transit system

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as separately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:

With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket 5 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station cleaner [**er**], terminal cleaner <u>or supervisory personnel</u> employed by any б 7 transit agency, authority or company, public or private, whose operation 8 is authorized by New York state or any of its political subdivisions, a 9 city marshal, a school crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two 10 hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, a traffic enforcement 11 officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation 12 13 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, public health sani-14 tarian, New York city public health sanitarian, registered nurse, 15 licensed practical nurse, emergency medical service paramedic, or emer-16 gency medical service technician, he or she causes physical injury to such train operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus 17 operator, station agent, station cleaner [**er**], terminal cleaner, **or** 18 supervisory personnel, city marshal, school crossing guard appointed 19 20 pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, 21 traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as 22 defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal proce-23 dure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, public health 24 sanitarian, New York city public health sanitarian, sanitation enforce-25 ment agent, New York city sanitation worker, emergency medical service
