AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to extortion or coercion related to immigration status

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 135.60 of the penal law, as  
2 amended by chapter 426 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as  
3 follows:  
4 4. Accuse some person of a crime or cause criminal charges or deportation proceedings to be instituted against him or her; or

6 § 2. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (e) of subdivision 2 of section  
7 155.05 of the penal law is amended to read as follows:  
8 (iv) Accuse some person of a crime or cause criminal charges or deportation proceedings to be instituted against him or her; or  
9  
10 § 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall  
11 have become a law.
