AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring insurance companies to cover annual mammograms for breast cancer screening for covered persons aged thirty-five and older

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 "Shannon's Law".

3 § 2. Subparagraph (A) of paragraph 11 of subsection (i) of section 4 3216 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 219 of the laws of 5 2011, is amended to read as follows:

6 (A) Every policy that provides coverage for hospital, surgical or 7 medical care shall provide the following coverage for mammography 8 screening for occult breast cancer:

9 (i) upon the recommendation of a physician, a mammogram at any age for 10 covered persons having a prior history of breast cancer or who have a 11 first degree relative with a prior history of breast cancer; <u>and</u>

12 (ii) [a single baseline mammogram for covered persons aged thirty-five 13 through thirty-nine, inclusive; and

14 (iii) an annual mammogram for covered persons aged [forty] thirty-15 five and older.

16 § 3. Subparagraph (A) of paragraph 11 of subsection (1) of section 17 3221 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 219 of the laws of 18 2011, is amended to read as follows:

19 (A) Every insurer delivering a group or blanket policy or issuing a 20 group or blanket policy for delivery in this state that provides cover-21 age for hospital, surgical or medical care shall provide the following 22 coverage for mammography screening for occult breast cancer:

Paragraph 1 of subsection (p) of section 4303 of the insurance 8 9 law, as amended by chapter 219 of the laws of 2011, subparagraph (D) as amended by chapter 74 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as 10 11 follows: (1) A medical expense indemnity corporation, a hospital service corpo-12 13 ration or a health service corporation that provides coverage for hospi-14 tal, surgical or medical care shall provide the following coverage for 15 mammography screening for occult breast cancer: 16 (A) upon the recommendation of a physician, a mammogram at any age for 17 covered persons having a prior history of breast cancer or who have a first degree relative with a prior history of breast cancer; and 18 19 [a single baseline mammogram for covered persons aged thirty-five (B) 20 through thirty-nine, inclusive; and 21 (C)] an annual mammogram for covered persons aged [forty] thirty-five 22 and older. (D) The coverage required in this paragraph or paragraph two of this 23 24 subsection shall not be subject to annual deductibles or coinsurance. § 5. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall apply to poli-25 26 cies and contracts issued, renewed, modified, altered or amended on or 27 after such effective date.
