AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to establishing a contract for the employment of domestic workers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 201-g to  
2 read as follows:  
3 § 201-g. Domestic worker contracts. 1. The commissioner shall establish the form and content of contracts for the employment of domestic  
4 workers. Every such contract shall include:  
5 a. a description of the employment and the duties that are expected to  
6 be performed in the course of such employment;  
7 b. the expected number of hours of work per week;  
8 c. provisions for vacation, holiday, personal and sick leave;  
9 d. the rate of wages paid for such employment; and  
10 e. consent to work overtime.  
11 2. No person shall employ any domestic worker unless such person has  
12 entered into a written contract, meeting the requirements of subdivision  
13 one of this section, with each domestic worker employed.  
14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after  
15 it shall have become a law.
