AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting businesses from charging a price for goods on the basis of gender

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- l Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new 2 section 391-u to read as follows:
- § 391-u. Charging a price for goods on the basis of gender prohibited.

 4 1. (a) No business shall charge a price for goods of a substantially similar or like kind on the basis of a person's gender.
- 6 (b) For the purposes of paragraph (a) of this subdivision, "substan-7 tially similar or like kind" shall be interpreted to mean such goods:
 - (i) share the same brand;

- 9 (ii) share the same functional components; and
- 10 (iii) share ninety percent of the same materials or ingredients.
- 11 (c) For the purposes of this section, "goods" shall not include:
- 12 <u>(i) any food as defined in subdivision three of section two of the</u>
 13 <u>agriculture and markets law; or</u>
- 14 (ii) goods sold by a new motor vehicle dealer as defined in paragraph
 15 f of subdivision one of section four hundred fifteen of the vehicle and
 16 traffic law.
 - 2. Nothing in subdivision one of this section shall prohibit:
- 18 <u>(a) price differences based specifically on the labor, materials,</u>
 19 <u>tariffs, or other gender-neutral reasons for having increased cost for</u>
 20 providing such goods; or
- 21 (b) a retail establishment from passing through a price to the consum-22 er that is set by a manufacturer, distributor, or other entity that a 23 retailer cannot control.
- 24 <u>3. Any business who shall violate the provisions of this section</u> 25 <u>shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a civil penalty of not less than</u>

1 fifty dollars and not more than two hundred fifty dollars for the first

- 2 offense and for each succeeding offense a penalty of not less than one
- 3 <u>hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars for each such</u>
- 4 violation. For the purpose of this section, each good priced on the
- 5 basis of gender shall be considered a single and separate violation.
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
