AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the offense of assault on a teacher

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 120.00-a 2 to read as follows:

3 § 120.00-a Assault on a teacher.

A person is guilty of assault on a teacher when, with intent to cause 5 physical injury to a teacher, he or she causes such injury to such teacher while upon school grounds as defined in subdivision fourteen of section 220.00 of this part.

Assault on a teacher is a class E felony.

- § 2. Subdivision 10 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 268 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 10. Acting at a place the person knows, or reasonably should know, is 12 on school grounds and with intent to cause physical injury, he or she[+
- 13 (a) causes such injury to an employee of a school or public school 14 district; or
- (b)], not being a student of such school or public school district, 16 causes physical injury to another, and such other person is a student of such school who is attending or present for educational purposes. For 17 purposes of this subdivision the term "school grounds" shall have the 18
- meaning set forth in subdivision fourteen of section 220.00 of this 19
- 20 [chapter] <u>part</u>; or

21 § 3. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-22 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
