- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to directing the commissioner of health, in consultation with the commissioner of transportation and the New York state emergency medical services council, to establish rules and regulations for ambulances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3011 of the public health law is amended by adding a new subdivision 12 to read as follows:

3 <u>12. The commissioner shall, in consultation with the commissioner of</u> 4 <u>transportation and the state council, establish rules and regulations</u> 5 <u>for ambulance services in order to ensure the physical safety of passen-</u> 6 <u>gers and the public at large during the transport of such passengers.</u> 7 <u>Such rules and regulations shall include, but shall not be limited to,</u> 8 <u>the allowable number of consecutive hours an ambulance driver may work</u> 9 <u>and the reguisite training an ambulance driver shall receive prior to</u> 10 <u>operating an ambulance.</u>

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law.
