AN ACT authorizing the town of Pendleton, county of Niagara, to reduce the maximum speed limit along a certain portion of Mapleton Road in such town to 45 miles per hour

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any general, special or local law or code to the contrary, the town board of the town of Pendleton, Niagara county, may by local law, ordinance, order, rule or regulation establish maximum speed limits at not less than forty-five miles per hour along Mapleton Road from the intersection with Campbell Boulevard through and including the intersection with Townline Road.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
