AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to a limited license for a speech-language pathologist

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 8206-a 2 to read as follows:
- 8 8206-a. Limited license. 1. The department shall issue a limited license to an applicant for a license as a speech-language pathologist who meets all requirements set forth in this section.
- 2. Any person engaging in clinical or academic practice under the supervision of a licensed speech-language pathologist for such period of time as may be necessary to complete an experience requirement for a professional license as a speech-language pathologist shall be eligible for a limited license.
- 3. A limited licensee shall be authorized to practice speech-language pathology only under the supervision of a licensed speech-language pathologist.
- 4. A limited license shall be valid for one year. It may be renewed for additional one year periods until such time as may be necessary to complete an experience requirement for a professional license as a

- 18 5. The fee for a limited license shall be seventy dollars.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 20 it shall have become a law.
