AN ACT to direct the department of environmental conservation to adopt rules and regulations requiring permitees to place air monitoring equipment near permitted waste transfer stations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. No later than January 1, 2020, the department of environmental conservation shall adopt rules and regulations requiring permittees to place air monitoring equipment at an appropriate distance from 4 permitted waste transfer stations to measure data for ozone, sulfur 5 dioxide, oxides of nitrogen, carbon dioxide, meteorological data, PM 1.0 6 and PM 2.5. Such regulations shall also require the monitoring of volatile organic compounds as ozone precursors during the summer for the purposes of determining the quality of ambient air and developing programs to target appropriate source categories for emission reduction. Resulting air quality data shall be required to be made available to the department and the public and posted on the department's website.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 13 law.
