AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a maximum temperature in school buildings and indoor facilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 409-m 2 to read as follows:

§ 409-m. Maximum temperatures in school buildings and facilities. All 4 common, union free, central, central high schools, city school districts 5 and boards of cooperative educational services shall develop a policy 6 for ensuring the health and safety of students and faculty on extreme heat condition days. For the purpose of this section, extreme heat condition days shall be defined as days when the occupiable educational 9 spaces are found to be ninety degrees Fahrenheit or greater. For the 10 purpose of this section, room temperature shall be measured at a shaded 11 location, three feet above the floor near the center of the room.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 13 it shall have become a law.
