Introduced by M. of A. GOTTFRIED -- read once and referred to the Committee on Education -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to admission of certain unvaccinated students to public schools

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 3201-b  
2 to read as follows:

3 § 3201-b. Procedure for religious exemption from vaccination require-  
4 ment. 1. The definitions of terms in section twenty-one hundred sixty-  
5 four of the public health law shall apply to this section. This section  
6 shall apply notwithstanding any general, special, local law or rule or  
7 regulation to the contrary. This section shall only apply with respect  
8 to admission or receiving of a child into a school, or attending a  
9 school, referred to in section one of article eleven of the New York  
10 state constitution, including a charter school.

11 2. Where a child's parent, parents or guardian claim that section  
12 twenty-one hundred sixty-four of the public health law shall not apply  
13 to the child because the parent, parents, or guardian hold genuine and  
14 sincere religious beliefs which are contrary to the practices required  
15 in such section, the child shall be deemed to have complied with that  
16 section and no certificate under that section shall be required as a  
17 prerequisite to such child being admitted or received into school or  
18 attending school, provided that the parent, parents or guardian file  
19 with the school a religious beliefs exemption form under subdivision  
20 three of this section.

21 3. Religious beliefs exemption form. Any parent, parents, or guardian  
22 requesting an exemption from the vaccination requirements of section  
23 twenty-one hundred sixty-four of the public health law based upon his,  
24 her or their genuine and sincere religious beliefs that are contrary to

1 the practices prescribed by such section shall complete the following  
2 religious beliefs exemption form and file it with the school:
