AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the issuance of permits authorizing the use of wild animals and elephants in circuses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 11-0540 to read as follows:
- 3 <u>§ 11-0540. Prohibition on the issuance of permits authorizing the use of</u>
 4 <u>wild animals and elephants in circuses.</u>
- 1. The department shall not issue a permit or license, including, but
 not limited to, an education or exhibition permit or an endangered or
 threatened species license, authorizing the exhibition of a wild animal,
 or elephant, in a circus, notwithstanding a valid United States department of agriculture license.
- 2. Such a prohibition shall not apply to:
- 11 a. an accredited zoo accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquari-
- 12 <u>ums;</u>
- b. a wildlife sanctuary.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020.
