AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to including bodegas and delicatessens in the definition of food service establishment

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision d of section 17-1501 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law 90 of the city of New York for the year 2013, is amended to read as follows:

- d. "Food service establishment" means any establishment, including a bodega or delicatessen, inspected pursuant to the restaurant grading program established pursuant to subdivision a of section 81.51 of the health code of the city of New York. For the purposes of this act, bodega shall mean a small grocery or convenience store and delicatessen shall mean a store selling cold cuts, cheeses, and a variety of salads, as well as a selection of unusual or foreign prepared foods.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
