AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to patient counseling before issuing a prescription for a schedule II opioid

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 3331 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 3 <u>2-a. Prior to issuing a prescription for a schedule II opioid, a practitioner shall:</u>
 - (a) consult with the patient regarding the quantity of the opioid and the patient's option to fill the prescription in a lesser quantity;
- 7 (b) inform the patient of the risks associated with opiate addiction; 8 and
- 9 (c) document the reason for the opioid prescription in the patient's 10 medical record.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the
- 13 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary
- 13 addition, amendment and/of repeat of any fute of regulation necessary
- 14 for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized
- 15 and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
