AN ACT to designate the "Bear Mountain bridge" as the "Purple Heart Veterans Memorial Bridge"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The Bear Mountain bridge, as defined in subdivision seven of section 526 of the public authorities law, shall be designated and known as the "Purple Heart Veterans Memorial Bridge".
- § 2. The chairman of the New York State Bridge Authority shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act
- 9 shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge
- 10 shall not be changed as a result of this act.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
