AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to authorizing, in certain cases, the provision of in-home private duty nursing services to a recipient of medical assistance by a relative who is a registered professional nurse

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 2 365-o to read as follows:

§ 365-o. Provision of in-home private duty nursing services by the relative of a recipient. Upon application or request to the commissioner by a recipient of medical assistance, or his or her representative or guardian, who has been approved for the provision of in-home private duty nursing, the commissioner may authorize the provision of such private duty nursing by an adult relative of such recipient, other than a spouse of the recipient, who is a registered professional nurse.

Reimbursement for private nursing services provided in accordance with this section shall be at the rate paid for the provision of such
