AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to permitting a driver to not have a hand on the steering mechanism of a vehicle while a driving automation system is engaged

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 1226 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by 2 chapter 506 of the laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

§ 1226. Control of steering mechanism. No person shall operate a motor vehicle without having at least one hand or, in the case of a physically handicapped person, at least one prosthetic device or aid on the steering mechanism at all times when the motor vehicle is in motion unless a driving automation system, as defined in SAE J3016 as periodically revised, is engaged to perform steering function.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-10 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to 11 violations committed on and after such date.
