AN ACT to establish a task force to study how to incentivize individuals in the state of New York to become pilots

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. a. A task force is hereby established to study how to incentivize individuals in the state of New York to become pilots.
  - b. The task force shall study:

- 4 (i) measures the state of New York has taken or may take to incentiv-5 ize individuals to become pilots;
  - (ii) measures airlines within the country have taken to incentivize individuals to become pilots;
- 8 (iii) measures other states have taken to incentivize individuals to 9 become pilots;
  - (iv) the effect of high-stress scheduling on pilots;
- 11 (v) why pilots are retiring at high rates despite financial incentives 12 to remain in the industry;
- 13 (vi) the cost of education and training for an individual to become 14 employed as a pilot; and
- 15 (vii) the effect of a strong aviation industry on state tourism.
- 16 c. No later than one year after the effective date of this act, the 17 task force shall report its findings to the governor and the legisla-18 ture, as described under subdivision b of this section.
  - § 2. a. The task force shall be comprised of:
- 20 (i) two members appointed by the governor;
- 21 (ii) two members appointed by the temporary president of the senate;
- 22 (iii) two members appointed by the speaker of the assembly; and
- 23 (iv) one member appointed by the commissioner of transportation.
- 24 b. One of the appointments by the governor shall serve as chairperson 25 of the task force.
- 26 c. The members of the task force shall receive no compensation for
- 27 their services, but shall be allowed their actual and necessary expenses
- 28 incurred in the performance of their services.
