AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring retailers to obtain a permit to sell vapor products

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
2	399-hh to read as follows:
3	§ 399-hh. Permits for sale of vapor products. 1. "Vapor product" means
4	any noncombustible liquid or gel, regardless of presence of nicotine
5	therein, that is manufactured into a finished product for use in an
б	electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic cigarillo, electronic
7	pipe, vaping pen, hookah pen or other similar device. "Vapor product"
8	shall include tobacco that is manufactured into a finished product for
9	use in a device which heats the tobacco but does not result in
10	combustion. "Vapor product" shall not include any product approved by
11	the United States food and drug administration as a drug or medical
12	device.
13	2. "Retailer" means any establishment in the state of New York which
14	<u>sells or intends to sell vapor products.</u>
15	3. Every retailer registered to do business in the state of New York
16	that intends to sell vapor products shall be required to obtain a permit
17	in order to sell vapor products in New York state. The department of
18	state shall promulgate any rules and regulations necessary for governing
19	the process whereby a retailer can apply for and receive a permit to
20	sell vapor products in New York state. Retailers with a permit shall
21	renew such permit once every five years.
22	§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after

23 it shall have become a law.
