AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as "Thurgood Marshall Interchange"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-f to read as follows:

3 § 344-f. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as 4 "Thurgood Marshall Interchange". All that portion of the state highway 5 system constituting the New York State thruway route 87/route 287 inter-6 change in the village of Hillburn, town of Ramapo, county of Rockland, 7 shall be designated and known as the "Thurgood Marshall Interchange".

8 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
