AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the sale of ammunition

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 270.00 of the penal law, as 2 amended by chapter 180 of the laws of 1997, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision four of this section, it shall be unlawful for any dealer in firearms to sell any ammunition [designed exclusively for use in a pistol or revolver] to any person, not authorized to possess [a pistol or revolver] such weapon, regardless of type.
- 9 <u>6.</u> The violation of this section shall constitute a class B misdemea-10 nor, except the violation of subdivision five of this section shall 11 constitute a class E felony.
- 2 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
