AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to directing the state board of elections to implement any necessary procedures allowing unaffiliated voters to vote in a primary

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 8-302 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 4-a to read as follows:

4 deal At a primary election, a voter, whose registration poll record is in the ledger as an unaffiliated registered voter, shall be granted the opportunity to vote in a single primary election of such voter's choice.

- § 2. The state board of elections shall implement any rules and regulations necessary to permit an unaffiliated, registered voter the opportunity to vote in a single primary election.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
