AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to state-issued parking placards

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 837-t to read as follows:

§ 837-t. State-issued parking placards. 1. All parking placards issued by the state of New York shall bear a barcode, which shall permit traffic enforcement agents to confirm the validity of such placards when displayed in a motor vehicle. Such barcode shall contain the name of the individual authorized to use the placard, the license plate of the vehicle in which such placard is displayed, the name of the agency for whom the individual using the placard is employed and a unique identification number specific to each placard.

11 <u>2. The commissioner shall establish an on-line registry and website</u> 12 <u>for all state-issued parking placards.</u>

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
