AN ACT to amend the legislative law, in relation to creation of the legislative budget office

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The legislative law is amended by adding a new article 5-C
2 to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5-C

LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE

3 Section 88-k. Non-partisan legislative budget office.

4 88-1. Powers and duties of the non-partisan legislative budget
5 office.

6 § 88-k. Non-partisan legislative budget office. There is hereby estab-
7 lished a non-partisan legislative budget office.

8 § 88-1. Powers and duties of the non-partisan legislative budget
9 office. 1. The non-partisan legislative budget office shall perform
10 budget analysis to determine the funding levels necessary to the opera-
11 tion of governmental departments and programs and render anticipated
12 revenue estimates for each fiscal year. Such revenue estimates shall be
13 used exclusively for purposes of determining budget expenditures.

14 2. The director of the non-partisan legislative budget office shall
15 examine and review all financial information of the state for the
16 purpose of rendering revenue estimates used in determining whether the
17 proposed state budget is balanced.

18 3. The non-partisan legislative budget office shall be headed by a
19 director who shall be appointed by a joint resolution of the senate and
20 assembly for a term of five years. He or she shall devote his or her
21 full time and effort to the office of director and he or she shall hold
22 no other public office. The director shall receive such compensation as
23 may be fixed by the office. The director may appoint budget analysts,

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1 assistants and such other employees as he or she may deem necessary or
2 desirable, prescribe their duties and fix their compensation within the
3 amounts appropriated and made available therefor.

4 4. The non-partisan legislative budget office shall be charged with
5 the duty of rendering anticipated revenue forecast reports to the legis-
6 lature and the governor for the purposes of facilitating passage of the
7 state budget in a timely manner. The director may request and shall
8 receive from all public officers, departments, agencies and authorities
9 of the state and its political subdivisions, such assistance and data as
10 shall be necessary to project anticipated state revenues for budgetary
11 purposes.

12 5. The non-partisan legislative budget office shall provide assistance
13 in determining the fiscal impact of proposed legislation.

14 6. The non-partisan legislative budget office shall submit to the
15 legislature written estimates of anticipated state revenues on January
16 fifteenth, April fifteenth, July fifteenth and October fifteenth of each
17 year.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
