AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to providing a "None of the Above" option on ballots in certain uncontested elections

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 7-116 of the election law is amended by adding a
2 new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

3 2-a. In every uncontested statewide, senate or assembly election, the
4 officer or board who or which prepares the ballot shall place below the
5 candidate listed for election an option which a voter may select that
6 shall read: NONE OF THE ABOVE. Only votes cast for the named candidate
7 shall be counted in determining nomination or election to any statewide,
8 senate or assembly office, but for each office the number of ballots on
9 which the "NONE OF THE ABOVE" option was chosen shall be listed follow-
10 ing the name of the candidate and the number of votes in every posting,
11 abstract and proclamation of the results of the election.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
