AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to enacting "Jacobe's law"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Jacobe's law." § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 15-a to read 3 as follows:
- § 15-a. Reporting by school administrators. 1. School administrators, or the school employee charged with receiving reports of harassment, bullying and discrimination, shall make a reasonable and good faith 7 effort to contact the parents or quardians of the students involved in 8 an incident of bullying or harassment after verifying, in accordance with the provisions of this article, that such incident has occurred.
- 10 2. The school administrator shall contact the parent or quardian by 11 telephone, electronic mail, regular mail or other means.
- 12 3. As used in this section:

- 13 a. "school administrator" shall have the same meaning as the term 14 defined by subdivision six of section eleven hundred twenty-five of this 15
- b. "school employee" shall have the same meaning as specified in para-16 17 graph a of subdivision one of section thirteen of this article; and
- 18 c. "harassment" and "bullying" shall have the same meaning as defined 19 under subdivision seven of section eleven of this article.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
