Introduced by Sens. RITCHIE, O'MARA, TEDISCO -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Social Services -- recommitted to the Committee on Social Services in accordance with Senate Rule 6, sec. 8 -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend chapter 58 of the laws of 2005, relating to authorizing reimbursements for expenditures made by or on behalf of social services districts for medical assistance for needy persons and the administration thereof, in relation to a five year elimination of the local share for medicaid

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (iv) of subdivision (c) of section 1 of part C of chapter 58 of the laws of 2005, relating to authorizing reimbursements for expenditures made by or on behalf of social services districts for medical assistance for needy persons, is amended and seven new subdivisions (c-2), (c-3), (c-4), (c-5), (c-6), (c-7) and (c-8) are added to read as follows:

(iv) 2009 (January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009), and each succeeding calendar year through 2021: prior year's trend factor percentage plus 3%.

(c-2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 368-a of the social services law, or any other provision of law, commencing with the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, calendar year social services district medical assistance expenditure amounts for each social services district shall be reduced by 20% from the 2021 expenditures. No less than 75% of the savings from this medical assistance expenditure reduction shall be used for property tax levy reductions, or property tax rebates, effective in the local government's 2023 fiscal year.

(c-3) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 368-a of the social services law, or any other provision of law, commencing with the period

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1 January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, calendar year social services  
2 district medical assistance expenditure amounts for each social services  
3 district shall be reduced by 40% from the 2021 expenditures. No less  
4 than 75% of the annual savings from this medical assistance expenditure  
5 reduction, compared to the prior year medical assistance expenditure,  
6 shall be used for property tax levy reductions, or property tax rebates,  
7 effective in the local government's 2024 fiscal year.

8 (c-4) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 368-a of the social  
9 services law, or any other provision of law, commencing with the period  
10 January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, calendar year social services  
11 district medical assistance expenditure amounts for each social services  
12 district shall be reduced by 60% from the 2021 expenditures. No less  
13 than 75% of the annual savings from this medical assistance expenditure  
14 reduction, compared to the prior year medical assistance expenditure,  
15 shall be used for property tax levy reductions, or property tax rebates,  
16 effective in the local government's 2025 fiscal year.

17 (c-5) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 368-a of the social  
18 services law, or any other provision of law, commencing with the period  
19 January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, calendar year social services  
20 district medical assistance expenditure amounts for each social services  
21 district shall be reduced by 80% from the 2021 expenditures. No less  
22 than 75% of the annual savings from this medical assistance expenditure  
23 reduction, compared to the prior year medical assistance expenditure,  
24 shall be used for property tax levy reductions, or property tax rebates,  
25 effective in the local government's 2026 fiscal year.

26 (c-6) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 368-a of the social  
27 services law, or any other provision of law, commencing with the period  
28 January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, calendar year social services  
29 district medical assistance expenditure amounts for each social services  
30 district shall be reduced by 100% from the 2021 expenditures; and shall  
31 remain eliminated each year thereafter. No less than 75% of the annual  
32 savings from this medical assistance expenditure reduction, compared to  
33 the prior year medical assistance expenditure, shall be used for proper-  
34 ty tax levy reductions, or property tax rebates, effective in the local  
35 government's 2027 fiscal year.

36 (c-7) Notwithstanding the provisions of section seven of this act, any  
37 county that opted into the local sales tax intercept methodology shall  
38 receive a proportionate reduction in the sales tax intercept as  
39 described in subdivisions (c-2), (c-3), (c-4), (c-5) and (c-6) of this  
40 section and use these recaptured funds for property tax reductions in  
41 the same manner as other local jurisdictions as described.

42 (c-8) The minimum amount of annual property tax levy reductions  
43 resulting from savings achieved as defined in subdivisions (c-2), (c-3),  
44 (c-4), (c-5) and (c-6) of this section, shall be determined by the state  
45 comptroller and transmitted to each local government one hundred eighty  
46 days in advance of the start of the fiscal year for which the property  
47 tax reduction is to be effective.

48 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
