AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to the metropolitan transportation authority providing signs that would give the public immediate instruction on how to react to a fall onto the transit facility tracks

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1277-b to read as follows:

§ 1277-b. Emergency transit facility signs. 1. The authority shall 4 create and post signage in a clear and conspicuous manner, in at least sixteen point font that will instruct the public on how to react when an individual falls onto the transit facility tracks.

- 2. Such signage shall be posted on every transit facility station.
- § 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a law.
