AN ACT to amend the public health law and chapter 802 of the laws of 1947 relating to facilitating the financing and effectuation of air terminals by the Port of New York Authority, in relation to requiring certain lactation accommodations in airports

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "lactation
2 accommodation in airports act".

3 § 2. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2505-b
4 to read as follows:

5 § 2505-b. Lactation accommodations in airports. 1. The airport manager
6 of a commercial service airport operated by a county, city, town, or
7 village that has one million or more enplanements a year shall provide a
8 room or other location at each airport passenger terminal behind the
9 airport security screening area for members of the public to express
10 breast milk in private that meets the following conditions:

11 (a) includes, at a minimum, a chair and an electrical outlet;

12 (b) is located outside of the confines of a public restroom; and

13 (c) upon completion of the construction of a new passenger terminal,
14 or the replacement, expansion, or renovation of an existing passenger
15 terminal, includes a sink.

16 2. The airport manager of a commercial service airport operated by a
17 county, city, town, or village that has fewer than one million, but more
18 than ten thousand enplanements a year shall, upon completion of the

1 construction of a new passenger terminal, or the replacement, expansion,
2 or renovation of an existing passenger terminal, provide a room or other
3 location at each airport passenger terminal behind the airport security
4 screening area for members of the public to express breast milk in
5 private that meets the following conditions:

6 (a) includes, at a minimum, a chair, a sink, and an electrical outlet;
7 and

8 (b) is located outside of the confines of a public restroom.

9 3. As used in this section, "renovation of an existing passenger
10 terminal" means the repurposing of more than twenty-five percent of the
11 space in the passenger terminal.

12 § 3. Chapter 802 of the laws of 1947 relating to facilitating the
13 financing and effectuation of air terminals by the Port of New York
14 Authority is amended by adding a new section 4-b to read as follows:

15 § 4-b. Lactation accommodations in airports. 1. Any airport main-
16 tained or operated by the Port Authority that has one million or more
17 enplanements a year shall provide a room or other location at each
18 airport passenger terminal behind the terminal security screening area
19 for members of the public to express breast milk in private that meets
20 the following conditions:

21 (a) includes, at a minimum, a chair and an electrical outlet;

22 (b) is located outside of the confines of a public restroom; and

23 (c) upon completion of the construction of a new passenger terminal,
24 or the replacement, expansion, or renovation of an existing passenger
25 terminal, includes a sink.

26 2. Any airport maintained or operated by the Port Authority that has
27 fewer than one million but more than ten thousand enplanements a year
28 shall, upon completion of the construction of a new passenger terminal,
29 or the replacement, expansion, or renovation of an existing passenger
30 terminal, provide a room or other location at each airport passenger
31 terminal behind the terminal security screening area for members of the
32 public to express breast milk in private that meets the following condi-
33 tions:

34 (a) includes, at a minimum, a chair, a sink, and an electrical outlet;
35 and

36 (b) is located outside of the confines of a public restroom.

37 3. As used in this section, "renovation of an existing passenger
38 terminal" means the repurposing of more than twenty-five percent of the
39 space in the passenger terminal.

40 § 4. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
41 ing the date on which it shall have become a law, provided, however,
42 section three of this act shall take effect upon the enactment into law
43 by the state of New Jersey of legislation having an identical effect
44 with this act but if the state of New Jersey shall have already enacted
45 such legislation, then this act shall take effect immediately. The
46 chairperson of the port authority shall notify the legislative bill
47 drafting commission upon the enactment into law of such legislation by
48 both such states in order that the commission may maintain an accurate
49 and timely effective data base of the official text of the laws of the
50 state of New York in furtherance of effecting the provisions of section
51 44 of the legislative law and section 70-b of the public officers law.
