AN ACT establishing a moratorium on the prohibition of feeding white-tailed deer in Sullivan county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 11-0325 of the environmental conservation law, or any other law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, in Sullivan county, a moratorium is imposed on the prohibition of feeding white-tailed deer. The moratorium shall continue in existence until January 1, 2024, or until the legislature determines, through legislative action, that the white-tailed deer population in Sullivan county has increased in such an amount as to warrant the removal of such moratorium prior to January 1, 2024.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
