AN ACT to amend the transportation law and the civil rights law, in relation to allowing therapy dogs to enter public places and public transportation

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 147 of the transportation law, as amended by chapter 536 of the laws of 2014, is amended to read as follows:

2 § 147. Dogs accompanying persons with a disability. 1. Subject to such
3 rules and regulations as the commissioner may prescribe, all common and
4 contract carriers of passengers by motor vehicle shall permit a guide
5 dog, hearing dog or service dog as defined in section forty-seven-b of
6 the civil rights law, or a therapy dog as defined in section forty-seven
7 of the civil rights law, accompanying a person with a disability, as
8 defined in subdivision twenty-one of section two hundred ninety-two of
9 the executive law, or an owner or handler of such dogs or such person
10 licensed to train such dogs, to accompany, to guide, or otherwise to aid
11 such disabled person, to ride on all vehicles operated for transportation
12 and no charge shall be made for the transportation of such dog.

13 2. For purposes of this section, "therapy dog" shall mean any dog that
14 is certified and trained to work or perform specific tasks for the benefit
15 of persons including those with special needs, autism, drug
16 addiction, distress due to emotional and physical abuse and clinical
17 depression or bipolar disease by a recognized therapy dog training
18 center or professional therapy dog trainer and is actually used for such
19 purpose.

20 § 2. Subdivision 1 of section 47 of the civil rights law, as amended
21 by chapter 404 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows:

22 1. (a) No person shall be denied admittance to and/or the equal use of
23 and enjoyment of any public facility solely because said person is a

1 person with a disability and is accompanied by a guide dog, hearing dog

4 (b) For purposes of this section, "therapy dog" shall mean any dog

11 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
