AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to designating the state and city universities of New York as participating agencies for voter registration form distribution and assistance, and permitting independent institutions of higher education to do the same upon request

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 5-211 of the election law, 2 as amended by chapter 265 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

Each agency designated as a participating agency under the provisions of this section shall implement and administer a program of distribution of voter registration forms pursuant to the provisions of this section. 7 The following offices which provide public assistance and/or provide state funded programs primarily engaged in providing services to persons with disabilities are hereby designated as voter registration agencies: 10 designated as the state agencies which provide public assistance are the office of children and family services, the office of temporary and 11 12 disability assistance, the department of family assistance and the 13 department of health. Also designated as public assistance agencies are all agencies of local government that provide such assistance. Desig-15 nated as state agencies that provide programs primarily engaged in providing services to people with disabilities are the department of labor, office for the aging, division of veterans' affairs, office of 17 18 mental health, office of vocational and educational services for indi-19 viduals with disabilities, commission on quality of care for the mental-20 ly disabled, office of mental retardation and developmental disabili-21 ties, commission for the blind, office of alcoholism and substance abuse 22 services, the office of the advocate for the disabled and all offices 23 which administer programs established or funded by such agencies. 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tional [state] participating agencies designated as voter registration offices are the department of state [and], the [division] district offices of the workers' compensation board, and all institutions of the 3 4 state university of New York and the city university of New York; and any degree-granting institution of higher education described in arti-6 cles one hundred fifteen, one hundred twenty-one, one hundred twenty-7 three, one hundred twenty-six and one hundred twenty-nine of title VII of the education law which elects to be a participating agency by filing 8 9 with the state board of elections a notice in which it makes such an 10 election. Such agencies shall be required to offer voter registration 11 forms to persons upon initial application for services, for participation in activities or for use of facilities, and upon renewal or 12 13 recertification for services, participation in activities or use of 14 facilities, and upon change of address relating to such services, 15 participation in activities or use of facilities of the agencies. 16 agencies shall also be responsible for providing assistance to appli-17 cants in completing voter registration forms, receiving and transmitting 18 the completed application form from all applicants who wish to have such 19 form transmitted to the appropriate board of elections. The state board 20 of elections shall, together with representatives of the **United States** 21 department of defense, develop and implement procedures for including recruitment offices of the armed forces of the United States as voter 22 registration offices when such offices are so designated by federal law. 23 24 state board of elections shall also make request of the United States [Immigration and Naturalization Service] Citizenship and Immi-25 26 gration Services to include applications for registration by mail with 27 any materials which are given to new citizens. All institutions of the state university of New York and the city university of New York, shall, 28 29 the beginning of the school year, and again in January of a year in 30 which the president of the United States is to be elected, provide an 31 application for registration to each student in each such institution. 32 The state board of elections may, by regulation, grant a waiver from any 33 or all of the requirements of this section to any office or program of 34 an agency, if it determines that it is not feasible for such office or 35 program to administer such requirement. 36

- § 2. Subdivision 4 of section 5-211 of the election law, as added by chapter 659 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:
- 4. Each participating agency shall provide to each applicant who does not decline to register to vote the same degree of assistance with regard to the completion of the registration application form as is provided by the agency with regard to the completion of its own form unless the applicant refuses such assistance. All institutions of the state university of New York and all degree-granting institutions of higher education described in articles one hundred fifteen, one hundred twenty-one, one hundred twenty-three, one hundred twenty-six and one hundred twenty-nine of title VII of the education law which have elected to be participating agencies pursuant to the opening paragraph of this section shall also provide such level of assistance to each person who wishes to complete an application for an absentee ballot.
- § 3. The opening paragraph of subdivision 8 of section 5-211 of the election law, as amended by chapter 659 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as follows:

Each participating agency, department, division or office that makes available voter registration forms or absentee ballot applications, or both, pursuant to this section shall offer with each application for the services or assistance, participation in activities or use of facilities

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1 of such agency, department, division or office and with each recertification, renewal or change of address form relating to such service or 3 assistance, participation in activities or use of facilities, a registration form together with instructions relating to eligibility to register and for completing the form except that forms used by the department of [social services] family assistance for the initial application for services, renewal or recertification for services and change 7 of address relating to such services shall physically incorporate a 9 voter registration application in a fashion that permits the voter 10 registration portion of the agency form to be detached therefrom. All 11 institutions of the state university of New York and all degree-granting institutions of higher education described in articles one hundred 12 fifteen, one hundred twenty-one, one hundred twenty-three, one hundred 13 14 twenty-six and one hundred twenty-nine of title VII of the education law 15 which have elected to be participating agencies pursuant to the opening 16 paragraph of this section shall also offer each such applicant an appli-17 cation for an absentee ballot. Such voter registration application shall 18 be designed so as to ensure the confidentiality of the source of the 19 application. Included on each participating agency's application for 20 services or assistance or on a separate form shall be: 21

§ 4. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law, provided however, that effective immediate-23 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rules or regulations 24 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 25 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such 26 effective date.
