AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring domestic violence awareness curriculum

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 804-e 2 to read as follows:

§ 804-e. Domestic violence awareness curriculum. 1. The commissioner shall establish a curriculum in consultation with the state office for the prevention of domestic violence and the department of social services, or instruction regarding domestic violence awareness to be available in school districts. The contents may be varied to meet the needs of particular school districts, or portions thereof, and need not be uniform throughout the state. The content shall be age appropriate and shall be developed according to the needs and abilities of pupils at 10 11 successive grade levels in order to provide skills, information, and 12 support to aid in domestic violence awareness.

2. Schools shall be permitted to include the above materials as a 14 component of its health curriculum or any other way the school deems 15 appropriate.

§ 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
