AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to freedom of information requests and attorneys' fees

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 89 of the public 1 2 officers law, as amended by chapter 492 of the laws of 2006, is amended 3 to read as follows: 4 (c) The court in such a proceeding may assess, against such agency involved, reasonable [attorney's] attorneys' fees and other litigation 5 costs reasonably incurred by such person in any case under the 6 7 provisions of this section in which such person has substantially 8 prevailed, [when: 9 i. the agency had no reasonable basis for denying access; or **ii.**] **and when** the agency failed to respond to a request or appeal 10 11 within the statutory time. The court in such proceeding shall assess, 12 against such agency involved, reasonable attorneys' fees and other liti-13 gation costs reasonably incurred by such person in any case under the 14 provisions of this section in which such person has substantially 15 prevailed and the court finds that the agency had no reasonable basis 16 for denying access.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
