AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a summer youth employment and career development program; and making an appropriation therefor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 1527-a  
2 to read as follows:

3 § 1527-a. Summer youth employment and career development program. 1.  
4 There shall be a summer youth employment and career development program  
5 supervised by the board of education and administered by guidance coun-  
6 selors of each district. The program shall encourage the development of  
7 part time and full time minimum wage paying internship positions for  
8 high school students, provide students with job training, placement  
9 services and career counseling and assist high school faculty in devel-  
10 oping and implementing a curriculum to provide students with work-compe-  
11 tency training.

12 2. Subject to the provisions of subdivision one of this section, each  
13 high school in the state shall have guidance counselors as permitted by  
14 budget allocations therefor: acting as liaisons between directors of all  
15 employment-related programs within the school, including cooperative  
16 education programs, training opportunities programs and school to  
17 employment programs; conducting job and career fairs; organizing field  
18 trips to local businesses, job fairs and career centers; compiling and  
19 maintaining current lists of all internship placements available includ-  
20 ing full-time and part-time employment opportunities; soliciting employ-  
21 ment opportunities for high school students from employers representing  
22 the public sector, private sector, community-based organizations and  
23 internship programs based on the current curriculum and geographical  
24 need of the district; endeavor to increase internship opportunities and

1 develop other work-experience programs for students; assisting students  
2 in securing full-time and part-time summer employment; providing train-  
3 ing in resume drafting and interviewing skills to program participants;  
4 and continuing to provide job placement and counseling services to  
5 program participants for one year subsequent to graduation.

6 3. Each school operating a summer youth employment and career develop-  
7 ment program shall be equipped with the necessary tools and resources to  
8 facilitate such program as deemed necessary by the commissioner and  
9 board of education, and shall be used to accommodate program staff to  
10 facilitate student career training and counseling.

11 § 2. The sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000), or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the department of educa-  
13 tion from any monies in the state treasury in the general fund to the  
14 credit of the local assistance account for purposes of providing for the  
15 state's share of the necessary appropriation to the state board of  
16 education for the operation of the summer youth employment and career  
17 development program established by this act provided, however, that no  
18 expenditures shall be made available from this appropriation for any  
19 purpose unless and until an appropriation to such board of education is  
20 made and then only in amounts matching such moneys paid to such board of  
21 education. Such sum shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the  
22 state comptroller on vouchers certified or approved by the commissioner  
23 of education, or his or her duly designated representative in the manner  
24 provided by law. Consistent with the foregoing provisions of this act,  
25 no expenditure shall be made from this appropriation until a certificate  
26 of approval of availability shall have been issued by the director of  
27 the budget and filed with the state comptroller and a copy filed with  
28 the chair of the senate finance committee and the chair of the assembly  
29 ways and means committee. Such certificate may be amended from time to  
30 time by the director of the budget and a copy of each such amendment  
31 shall be filed with the state comptroller, the chair of the senate  
32 finance committee and the chair of the assembly ways and means commit-  
33 tee.

34 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
