AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the New York state masters-in-education teacher incentive scholarship program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 669-f of the education law, as added by section 1 of subpart A of part EE of chapter 56 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

1. Eligibility. Students who are matriculated in an approved master's 5 degree in education program at a New York state [public institution of 6 higher education college, as defined in subdivision two of section six 7 hundred one of this title, leading to a career as a teacher in public elementary or secondary education shall be eligible for an award under this section, provided the applicant: (a) earned an undergraduate degree 10 from a college located in New York state; (b) was a New York state resident while earning such undergraduate degree; (c) achieved academic excellence as an undergraduate student, as defined by the corporation in 11 12 13 regulation; (d) enrolls in full-time study in an approved master's 14 degree in education program at a New York state [public institution of 15 higher education college, as defined in subdivision two of section six 16 hundred one of this title, leading to a career as a teacher in public 17 elementary or secondary education; (e) signs a contract with the corpo-18 ration agreeing to teach in a classroom setting on a full-time basis for 19 five years in a school located within New York state providing public
