AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to creating the career and practical education pathway to a high school diploma

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to
2	read as follows:
3	§ 817. Career and practical education pathway to a high school diplo-
4	ma. 1. a. A career and practical education (CPE) pathway to a high
5	school diploma is hereby established. A CPE pathway to a diploma, made
б	<u>available by a school district shall:</u>
7	<u>(i) result in a general diploma;</u>
8	(ii) differ from the traditional requirements to a general diploma
9	with respect to required assessments, except as otherwise required by
10	federal law; and
11	(iii) be made available to all students, including students with disa-
12	<u>bilities and English language learners.</u>
13	b. A CPE pathway to a diploma shall be based on a course of study
14	designed to provide students with practical knowledge and skills and
15	shall demonstrate that the student is ready for a career as determined
16	by regulations of the board of regents. A CPE pathway to a diploma shall
17	<u>include, but not be limited to:</u>
18	(i) completion of a CPE course of study;
19	(ii) completion of school given final exams;
20	(iii) completion of work-based learning experiences as provided by the
21	state approved program; and
22	(iv) completion of a work-skills employability profile.
23	c. For purposes of this section, a career and practical education
24	shall include, but not be limited to, a course of study in the following

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1	career fields: agriculture education, business and marketing education,
2	family and consumer sciences education, health occupations education,
3	technical education, technology education, practical arts education and

5	2. The board of regents shall promulgate such regulations to the
6	commissioner as may be necessary to create the curriculum, assessments
7	and any other criteria that students must achieve to earn a general
8	<u>diploma via a CPE pathway.</u>
9	3. Students first entering twelfth grade in the two thousand sixteen-
10	-two thousand seventeen school year and thereafter shall be eligible to

- earn a diploma via a CPE pathway.
  § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
