AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to bay constables appointed by a county, city, town or village within the definition of peace officers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 18 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure
2 law, as amended by chapter 224 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 18. Bay [~~constable of the city of Rye, the villages of Mamaronock,~~
5 ~~South Nyack and bay constables of the towns of East Hampton, Hempstead,~~
6 ~~Oyster Bay, Riverhead, Southampton, Southold, Islip, Shelter Island,~~
7 ~~Brookhaven, Babylon, Smithtown, Huntington and North Hempstead,~~
8 ~~provided, however, that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to~~
9 ~~authorize the bay constables in the city of Rye, the village of South~~
10 ~~Nyack or the towns of Brookhaven, Babylon, Southold, East Hampton,~~
11 ~~Riverhead, Islip, other than a bay constable of the town of Islip who~~
12 ~~prior to April third, nineteen hundred ninety-eight served as harbormas-~~
13 ~~ter for such town and whose position was reclassified as bay constable~~
14 ~~for such town prior to such date, Smithtown, Huntington and Shelter~~
15 ~~Island to carry, possess, repair or dispose of a firearm unless the~~
16 ~~appropriate license therefor has been issued pursuant to section 400.00~~
17 ~~of the penal law]~~ constables appointed by a county, city, town or
18 village.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
