AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to allowing a private right of action for improper debt collection

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 602 of the general business law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

3

4. A debtor shall have a private right of action against any person or 4 persons in violation of this article. Such person or persons shall be 5 liable to the debtor for any actual damages the debtor sustained as a result of the violation of this article, any punitive damages awarded by the court, and reasonable attorney's fees.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
